## Acceptable Alternative Student Projects

- 1. Create a game for others to play to learn the information.
- 2. Create a radio or television broadcast or a video production.
- 3. Write a dairy or journal of an important historical event or person; write a speech a person might have given at the time.
- 4. Write a song, rap, poem, advertisement, or jingle.
- 5. Create a travel brochure for another country or planet.
- 6. Write a script for a play or a mock trial.
- 7. Write a how-to manual for those who need instruction on how to do or use something.
- 8. Create a chart or poster to represent synthesis of material.
- Working with several other learners, create a panel discussion about a topic of a certain historical time period or about how different historical figures might react to a current problem of today.
- 10. Create an invention to fulfill a personal or social need.
- 11. Make a model; describe its parts and the functions of each.
- 12. Survey others; transfer your data to a chart or graph.
