

## GRAIN SIZE VISUAL: GOAL, STRATEGY, ACTION TASK AND INDICATOR DEFINITIONS

Goal -A broad statement that specifies a desired change 1) in student performance to close a gap or 2) an improved opportunity or potential for improved learning; and identifies the end result to be achieved within a given timeframe.

Strategy – A key approach the district will implement; written as a specific, measurable statement about what is going to be accomplished to meet a need and get closer to reaching a goal within a given timeframe.

Actions- A specific steps to operationalize a strategy and achieve a goal. Tasks – A list of activities that need to be done in order for someone to complete an action

Adult Implementation and
Student Performance Indicators –
Strategy indicators are the gauges
by which a strategy is determined
to be met in terms of student

A **baseline measure** establishes a starting point.

**Progress measures** assess short-term measures of change.
