### Become a Certified OLAC Facilitator—FREE Training Sessions

By becoming a certified OLAC facilitator, you will become familiar with and gain an enhanced working knowledge in the following:

- The **updated OLAC web platform** with new features and functionality
- How to use OLAC module, webinar, podcast, and video content to enhance the effectiveness of district and building leadership teams and teacher-based teams (DLTs, BLTs, TBTs)
- **Updated Ohio Principal Evaluation System (OPES) Crosswalk**—Lead superintendents/principals through the Principal Crosswalk, which aligns relevant OLAC modules, webinars, podcasts, and videos to the Ohio Principal Standards
- **Updated Ohio Teacher Evaluation System (OTES) Crosswalk**—Lead principals/teachers through the Teacher Crosswalk, which aligns relevant OLAC modules, webinars, podcasts, and videos to the Ohio Standards for the Teaching Profession. Crosswalks are provided for OTES 1.0 and 2.0.
- OLAC facilitators will be able to demonstrate how superintendents, principals, and teachers can develop a **professional growth plan** that has anytime capability and is free to the participants
- **Credit Options**—OLAC facilitators will become familiar with templates of various workshop offerings using OLAC modules that can be presented to colleges and universities for consideration for college credit. Facilitators will also become familiar for LPDC credit options available.
