Andy Hargreaves, Research Professor, Boston College & Visiting Professor, University of Ottawa **LEADING FROM THE MIDDLE**

In the face of a global pandemic, catastrophic weather events, war, racism, and attacks on democracy, how should educational leaders respond? How can leaders enable their schools and districts to be agile, safe, and effective places of learning that help young people develop the knowledge and character that will empower them to shape their futures? While some schools and districts have taken top-down or bottom-up approaches, explore a new type of leadership—leadership from the middle—which becomes a driver of transformational change.

Drawing from research with educational leaders across the United States, United Kingdom, and Canada, discover a

type of leadership that regards obstacles as opportunities, embraces leadership paradox, and is collaborative, inspiring, and inclusive. Expanding off of his ground-breaking book, learn more about what this type of leadership looks like, but also how it is most effective in addressing complex problems and in educating young people to develop diverse global competencies to prepare them for their futures.
