Methods	Description
Choral responding	All students answer a question in unison and response cards.
Response cards	Response cards are erasable boards on which all students write their answers to a question and then hold the boards up for the teacher to see.
Classwide peer	Students, in pairs, provide each other with instruction either using rapid
tutoring (CWPT)	responses (i.e., flash cards) or reading practice. They provide each
	other with immediate feedback. During CWPT, the classroom teacher
	circulates through the classroom and assists student pairs, as needed
Computer assisted	Students work individually or in small groups using computer
instruction	programs that provide material tailored to learner needs, frequent
	opportunities to respond, and immediate feedback.
Guided notes	Guided notes are partially completed outlines of content matter that the
	student completes during a lecture or when reading a chapter.
